Dear Chairman Briggs:

On June 3, 2013, at a Special Meeting of the El Dorado Hills Community Services District, over 150 concerned residents of the community attended and twenty-one members of the public spoke in support of keeping the former executive golf course as open space and/or developing the 98-acre property into a park with active and passive uses.

Following the comments from the public, the El Dorado Hills CSD Board of Directors voted unanimously to send this letter to the El Dorado County Planning Commission and Board of Supervisors asking you to consider land use alternatives for the 98-acres of the former executive golf course while also authorizing the District to work with other local districts and organizations to prepare a draft plan to acquire all or part of this property.

Approval of the proposed amendments to the general plan that would allow for residential and/or mixed use development of this property would forever preclude a visionary opportunity to create a public treasure in the form of a central park for El Dorado Hills.
